How it Works

The PetSafe® Audible Bark Collar effectively deters nuisance barking, using the innovative new SoundBurst™ technology that provides an effective alternate to static stimulation. The vibration of a dog's bark triggers the sensor. This causes the bark collar to emit a uniquely engineered, harmless burst of sound resembling the "spray" of an aerosol can. Your dog will quickly learn to associate his barking with the audible stimulation and will bark less as a result.

Training and Usage Tips

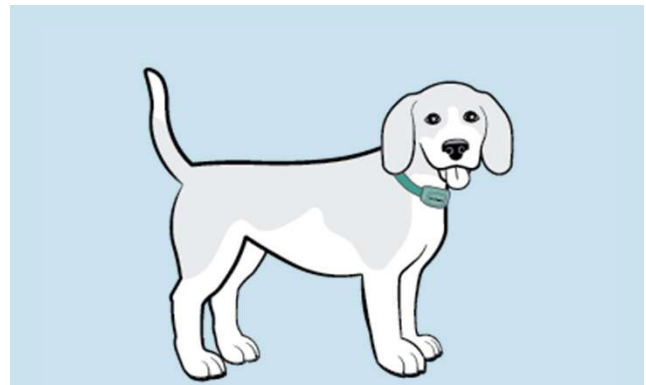
Introducing the collar: Stay with the dog the first few times he wears the collar. He may initially be startled by the noise of the collar and bark more. If this happens, dog owners should reassure the dog in a calm voice until he relaxes. He'll soon realise that the noise stops when he is quiet.

What to expect: Dogs should typically reduce barking within the first couple of days of wearing the collar. Still, dogs may test the collar and increase their attempts to bark. If this occurs, it's important to remain consistent and not alter use of the bark collar.

Be consistent: Use the bark collar in every situation in which you want your dog to be quiet. If your dog realises he is not wearing the collar, he may resume his barking habits and his learning will be delayed. As with any behaviour tool, using this product in conjunction with positive training techniques can result in a premium experience.

Attach your leash separately: when using a leash, attach it to a separate, non-metallic collar.

Maximise battery life: Turn off the bark collar when not in use. The battery can last up to 40 hours depending on how frequently your dog barks.



Fitting the Collar

- ✓ With the dog standing comfortably, place the bark collar around the dog's neck. The Petsafe® logo should be right side up and the bark sensor on the back of the collar should be centred directly under the dog's chin, touching his skin.
- ✓ The skin contact is necessary for the bark sensor to accurately recognise when your dog is barking. For dogs with long hair, it may be necessary to trim – but not shave – the hair around the bark sensor to make sure the contact is consistent.
- ✓ Check the tightness of the bark collar by inserting one finger between the end of the bark sensor and your dog's neck. The fit should be snug but not constricting.

For dogs 3.6 kg and up, and over 6 months.
